## COGS' revised Constitution – explanatory table

## Introduction

One of the recommendations from the February Strategic Planning workshop was to review and revise COGS' Constitution. According to <u>From Bare Earth to Bounty</u> (the story of COGS) the then Canberra Organic Growers adopted our first formal constitution in 1981. A new constitution was drafted in April 1985 to facilitate incorporation, and the name changed to Canberra Organic Growers' Society. A further update was done around 1990 to meet the expected needs of the 1991 Act.

Workshop attendees asked that the revision:

- meet the requirements of the recently updated ACT Associations Incorporation Act 1991
- modify COGS' objectives to reflect our current aspirations and operations
- update administrative arrangements to account for developments in banking and communication technologies
- update the language to make the Constitution a more readable document.

The tables below identify the proposed changes and explain the reasons for these changes.
